13 14 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 11-15 by rewriting those lines to read:

"SECTION 3. The Department of Correction shall study the potential benefits and costs of contracting for maintenance services at prison facilities and report its findings to the 2011 Regular Session of the General Assembly on the date of its reconvening in 2012. The Department shall not expand private maintenance contracts to additional prison facilities prior to July 1, 2012.

SECTION 3.1. If House Bill 200, 2011 Regular Session becomes law, then effective January 1, 2012, Section 3 of this act reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 3. The Department of Correction—Public Safety shall study the potential benefits and costs of contracting for maintenance services at prison facilities and report its findings to the 2011 Regular Session of the General Assembly on the date of its reconvening in 2012. The Department shall not expand private maintenance contracts to additional prison facilities prior to July 1, 2012.""
