1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO AMEND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT
3 SYSTEM TO INCLUDE THE NORTH CAROLINA SHERIFFS' ASSOCIATION AS AN
4 EMPLOYER.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.(a)** The North Carolina Sheriffs' Association is an instrumentality of
7 the State because it is controlled by the constitutionally elected Sheriffs of the State; acts on a
8 collective basis to support the Sheriffs in their constitutionally mandated duties; provides
9 coordination between State government officials and agencies; serves as a central information
10 clearinghouse for Sheriffs' offices; provides input on minimum standards for the operation of
11 local confinement facilities; and is required by statute to appoint members to boards and
12 commissions, including the North Carolina Sheriffs' Education and Training Standards
13 Commission.

14 **SECTION 1.(b)** G.S. 128-21 reads as rewritten:

15 "§ 128-21. Definitions.

16 The following words and phrases as used in this Article, unless a different meaning is
17 plainly required by the context, shall have the following meanings:

18 ...

19 (11) "Employer" shall mean any county, incorporated city or town, the board of
20 alcoholic control of any county or incorporated city or town, the North
21 Carolina League of Municipalities, ~~and the State Association of County~~
22 ~~Commissioners.~~ Commissioners, and the North Carolina Sheriffs'
23 Association. "Employer" shall also mean any separate, juristic political
24 subdivision of the State as may be approved by the Board of Trustees upon
25 the advice of the Attorney General.

27 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2011.
