1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 7 by rewriting that line to read:

3 "COMMISSIONERS AND TO PROVIDE A PROCESS BY WHICH UNITS OF LOCAL
4 GOVERNMENT MAY REGISTER OBJECTION TO LOCAL ACTS OF THE GENERAL
5 ASSEMBLY.";

7 and on page 4, lines 11-12 by inserting the following between those lines:

8 "SECTION 5.5.(a) Chapter 160A is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 "§ 160A-496.5. Registering objection to local acts.

10 (a) Governing boards of cities, counties, local boards of education, unified
11 governments, sanitary districts, and consolidated city-counties may adopt a resolution
12 registering objection to any local act of the General Assembly altering the form of government
13 of that unit, and submit that resolution to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and
14 President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

15 (b) If the resolution is received prior to the consideration of the local act on the floor of
16 the chamber, that chamber shall conduct a public hearing on the matter prior to consideration of
17 the floor of the chamber.

18 (c) This section shall apply to any city, county, local board of education, unified
19 government, sanitary district, or consolidated city-county."

20 SECTION 5.5.(b) This section shall become effective January 1, 2013 and apply to
21 any local bill filed on or after that date."
