The House recedes from House Amendment #1 and the House and Senate agree to the following amendment:

on page 1, lines 12-19, by rewriting the lines to read:

"collect any fee for such services. The Any person so practicing without license-being duly licensed and registered in this State shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor, except that if the person so practicing without a license is an out of state practitioner who has not been licensed and registered to practice medicine or surgery in this State, the person shall be guilty of a Class I felony. Class 1 misdemeanor. Any person so practicing without being duly licensed and registered in this State and who is falsely representing himself or herself in a manner as being licensed or registered under this Article or any Article of this Chapter shall be guilty of a Class I felony. Any person so practicing without being duly licensed and registered in this State and who is an out-of-state practitioner shall be guilty of a Class I felony. Any person who has a license or approval under this Article that is inactive due solely to the failure to complete annual registration in a timely fashion as required by this Article or any person who is licensed,
