It is the intent of the General Assembly to prescribe a uniform system for	the regulation of
legally carrying a concealed handgun. To insure uniformity, no political subd	
or agencies of the State nor any county, city, municipality, municipal co	rporation, town,
township, village, nor any department or agency thereof, may enact ordin	iances, rules, or
regulations concerning legally carrying a concealed handgun. A unit of local s	government may
adopt an ordinance to permit the posting of a prohibition against carrying a con	cealed handgun,
in accordance with G.S. 14-415.11(c), on local government buildings, the	ieir appurtenant
premises, and parks.buildings and their appurtenant premises."	



SECTION 4. This act becomes effective December 1, 2011.
