1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 12-25, by deleting those lines and substituting the
2 following:

4 "SECTION 1.1.(a) General Fund Appropriation. - Notwithstanding
5 G.S. 143C-5-2, there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Reserve for the State Health
6 Plan in the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of nineteen million nine hundred
7 seven thousand three hundred ten dollars (\$19,907,310) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and the
8 sum of one hundred twenty-six million four hundred ninety thousand four hundred sixty-one
9 dollars (\$126,490,461) for the 2012-2013 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to cover health
10 care and administrative costs to the Plan in the 2011-2013 fiscal biennium.

11 SECTION 1.1.(b) Highway Fund Appropriation. - Notwithstanding
12 G.S. 143C-5-2, there is appropriated from the Highway Fund to the Reserve for the State
13 Health Plan in the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of nine hundred twenty-
14 nine thousand eight dollars (\$929,008) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and the sum of five
15 million nine hundred two thousand eight hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$5,902,888) for the
16 2012-2013 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to cover health care and administrative costs
17 to the Plan in the 2011-2013 fiscal biennium."; and

19 on page 2, lines 3-13, by deleting those lines and substituting the following:

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24 SECTION 1.2.(b) Contributory Coverage. - Premium rates for contributory
25 coverage established in accordance with G.S. 135-44.6 shall be increased by five and
26 nine-tenths percent (5.9%) for contributory coverage for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and shall be
27 increased by an additional five and nine-tenths percent (5.9%) over the premium rate for
28 contributory coverage for the 2012-2013 fiscal year."; and

1 on page 10, lines 36-47, by deleting those lines and substituting the following:
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3 "SECTION 1.8.(d) Effective July 1, 2011, the maximum annual employer
4 contributions, payable monthly, by the State for each covered employee or retiree for the
5 2011-2012 fiscal year to the State Health Plan for Teachers and State Employees are: (i)
6 Medicare-eligible employees and retirees – three thousand seven hundred ninety-five dollars
7 (\$3,795) and (ii) non-Medicare-eligible employees and retirees – four thousand nine hundred
8 eighty-four dollars (\$4,984).

9 "SECTION 1.8.(e) Effective July 1, 2012, the maximum annual employer
10 contributions, payable monthly, by the State for each covered employee or retiree for the
11 2012-2013 fiscal year to the State Health Plan for Teachers and State Employees are: (i)
12 Medicare-eligible employees and retirees – four thousand eighteen dollars (\$4,018) and (ii)
13 non-Medicare-eligible employees and retirees – five thousand two hundred seventy-eight
14 dollars (\$5,278)."
