"SECTION 1.1.(a) General Fund Appropriation. — Notwithstanding G.S. 143C-5-2, there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Reserve for the State Health Plan in the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of ninety-six million four hundred six thousand nine hundred thirty-one dollars (\$96,406,931) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred ninety-seven million two hundred six thousand nine hundred four dollars (\$197,206,904) for the 2012-2013 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to cover health care and administrative costs to the Plan in the 2011-2013 fiscal biennium.

SECTION 1.1.(b) Highway Fund Appropriation. – Notwithstanding G.S. 143C-5-2, there is appropriated from the Highway Fund to the Reserve for the State Health Plan in the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of four million four hundred ninety-eight thousand nine hundred ninety dollars (\$4,498,990) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and the sum of nine million two hundred two thousand nine hundred eighty-nine dollars (\$9,202,989) for the 2012-2013 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to cover health care and administrative costs to the Plan in the 2011-2013 fiscal biennium."; and
