1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 6-32 by rewriting these lines to read:

2 **SECTION 1.** Section 15 of Article II of the North Carolina Constitution reads as  
3 rewritten:

4 "**Sec. 15. Officers of the House of Representatives.**

5 The House of Representatives shall elect its Speaker and other officers. No person may  
6 serve as Speaker in more than two regular sessions of the General Assembly."

7 **SECTION 2.** Section 14(1) of Article II of the North Carolina Constitution reads  
8 as rewritten:

9 "(1) President Pro Tempore – succession to presidency. The Senate shall elect from its  
10 membership a President Pro Tempore, who shall become President of the Senate upon the  
11 failure of the Lieutenant Governor-elect to qualify, or upon succession by the Lieutenant  
12 Governor to the office of Governor, or upon the death, resignation, or removal from office of  
13 the President of the Senate, and who shall serve until the expiration of his term of office as  
14 Senator.

15 No person may serve as President Pro Tempore in more than two regular sessions of the  
16 General Assembly."
