6 "SECTION 1. Article 8 of Chapter 120 of the General Statutes is amended by
7 adding a new section to read:

8 "§ 120-38. Term limits for Speaker of the House of Representatives and President Pro
9 Tempore.

10 (a) No person may serve as Speaker in more than two General Assemblies. The initial
11 convening of a session of the General Assembly after the terms of members commence shall
12 constitute a new General Assembly for the purpose of this Section. Only service as Speaker
13 during any part of an odd-numbered year constitutes service as Speaker for that General
14 Assembly for the purpose of this Section. Service as Speaker prior to January 1, 2013 shall not
15 be considered for the purpose of this subsection.

16 (b) No person may serve as President Pro Tempore in more than two General
17 Assemblies. The initial convening of a session of the General Assembly after the terms of
18 members commence shall constitute a new General Assembly for the purpose of this Section.
19 Only service as President Pro Tempore during any part of an odd-numbered year constitutes
20 service as President Pro Tempore for that General Assembly for the purpose of this Section.
21 Service as President Pro Tempore prior to January 1, 2013 shall not be considered for the
22 purpose of this subsection."

23 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law
