1 moves to amend the bill on page 5, line 23, by adding the following before the quote:

2 "(15) With regard to seafood and aquaculture:

- 3 a To monitor and study the seafood industry in North Carolina
- 4 including studies of the feasibility of increasing the State's
- 5 production, processing, and marketing of seafood.
- 6 b. To study the potential for increasing the role of aquaculture in all
- 7 regions of the State.
- 8 c. To evaluate the feasibility of creating a central permitting office for
- 9 fishing and aquaculture matters.
- 10 d. To evaluate actions of the Division of Marine Fisheries of the
- 11 Department of Environment and Natural Resources, the Wildlife
- 12 Resources Commission of the Department of Environment and
- 13 Natural Resources and of any other State or local government agency
- 14 as such actions relate to the seafood and aquaculture industries.
- 15 e. To make recommendations regarding regulatory matters relating to
- 16 the seafood and aquaculture industries including, but not limited to
- 17 evaluating the necessity to substantially increase penalties for
- 18 trespass and theft of shellfish and other aquaculture products.
- 19 f. To review and evaluate changes in federal law and regulations,
- 20 relevant court decisions, and changes in technology affecting the
- 21 seafood and aquaculture industries.
- 22 g. To review existing and proposed State law and rules affecting the
- 23 seafood and aquaculture industries and to determine whether any
- 24 modification of law or rules is in the public interest."


