1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO MODIFY THE FEES FOR TEACHER CERTIFICATION AND
3 ADMINISTRATIVE CHANGES TO CERTIFICATION.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-296(a2) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a2) The State Board of Education shall ~~impose the following schedule of adopt~~ fees for
7 teacher certification and administrative ~~changes; changes in a rule following the procedures~~
8 established by the Administrative Procedure Act in accordance with the following schedule:

- 9 (1) Application for demographic or administrative changes to a certificate,
10 \$30.00; up to \$45.00.
11 (2) Application for a duplicate certificate or for copies of documents in the
12 certification files, \$30.00; up to \$45.00.
13 (3) Application for a renewal, extension, addition, upgrade, and variation to a
14 certificate, \$55.00; up to \$80.00.
15 (4) Initial application for New, In-State Approved Program Graduate, \$55.00; up
16 to \$80.00.
17 (5) Initial application for Out-of-State certificate, \$85.00; up to \$125.00.
18 (5a) In-State certificate review, up to \$80.00.
19 (5b) Verification of North Carolina certificate for another state, up to \$80.00.
20 (6) All other applications, \$85.00.

21 The applicant must pay the fee at the time the application is submitted. The fee is
22 nonrefundable.

23 The State Board shall implement an online licensure management system to permit persons
24 to submit teacher certification and administration change applications electronically. If the
25 Department of Public Instruction is able to process online applications at less cost, the State
26 Board shall adopt lower fees for online applications."

27 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2011.
