A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE VARIOUS
SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-63(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Every license plate must display the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of the State of North Carolina, which may be abbreviated, and the year number for which it is issued or the date of expiration. A plate issued for a commercial vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.2(1), and weighing 26,001 pounds or more, must bear the word "commercial," unless the plate is a special registration plate authorized in G.S. 20-79.4 or the commercial vehicle is a trailer or is licensed for 6,000 pounds or less. The plate issued for vehicles licensed for 7,000 pounds through 26,000 pounds must bear the word "weighted," unless the plate is a special registration plate authorized in G.S. 20-79.4.

Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a registration plate issued by the Division for a private passenger vehicle or for a private hauler vehicle licensed for 6,000 pounds or less shall be a "First in Flight" plate. A "First in Flight" plate shall have the words "First in Flight" printed at the top of the plate above all other letters and numerals. The background of the plate shall depict the Wright Brothers biplane flying over Kitty Hawk Beach, with the plane flying slightly upward and to the right. The following special registration plates do not have to be a "First in Flight" plate. The design of the plates that are not "First in Flight" plates must be approved by the Division and the State Highway Patrol for clarity and ease of identification.

27 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-79.4 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

28 "(a3) The Division shall develop, in consultation with the State Highway Patrol and the
 29 Department of Correction, a standardized format for special license plates. The format shall
 30 allow for the license plate number to be easily read by the human eye and by cameras installed
 31 along roadways as part of tolling and speed enforcement. A designated segment of the plate
 32 shall be set aside for unique design representing various groups and interests. Nothing in this
 33 subsection shall be construed to require the recall of existing special license plates."

34 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

35 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration plates:

18 before this plate may be developed. A person may obtain a special

16 one to the first city in the list. For a county clerk, the plate shall bear the
17 words "County Clerk" followed by a number representing the county clerk's
18 county. The number of a county shall be the order of the county in an

20 list. The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision
21 unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate.

45 municipalities incorporated with an effective date after July 1, 2009, shall be

19 the "Boy Scouts of America" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall
20 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
21 from the sale of "Boy Scouts of America" plates to the Old Hickory Council of the Boy Scouts
22 of America, where the proceeds will be divided equally among the Boy Scouts of America
23 Councils in this State to be used for educational programs, preservation programs, capital
24 improvements on facilities located in this State, and related administrative and operating
25 expenses.

26 (b79) Brenner Children's Hospital. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications
27 for the "Brenner Children's Hospital" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division
28 shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account
29 derived from the sale of "Brenner Children's Hospital" plates to the NCBH Special
30 Purpose-Pediatric Unit Fund to provide funding for Brenner Children's Hospital.

31 (b80) Carolina Raptor Center. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for a
32 "Carolina Raptor Center" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer
33 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
34 sale of "Carolina Raptor Center" plates to the Carolina Raptor Center to be used for educational
35 materials, preservation programs, capital improvements for the Carolina Raptor Center, and
36 operating expenses of the Carolina Raptor Center.

37 (b81) Carolina Regional Volleyball Association. – The Division must receive 300 or more
38 applications for the "Carolina Regional Volleyball Association" plate before the plate may be
39 developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural
40 Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of the "Carolina Regional Volleyball
41 Association" plates to the Carolina Regional Volleyball Association to promote and develop the
42 sport of volleyball throughout North Carolina.

43 (b82) Carolinas Credit Union Foundation. – The Division must receive 300 or more
44 applications for the "Carolinas Credit Union Foundation" plate before the plate may be
45 developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural
46 Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "Carolinas Credit Union Foundation" plates
47 to the Carolinas Credit Union Foundation, Inc., for youth-focused programs.

48 (b83) Carolinas Golf Association. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications
49 for the "Carolinas Golf Association" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division
50 shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account

1 derived from the sale of "Carolinas Golf Association" plates to the Carolinas Golf Association
2 to be used to promote amateur golf in North Carolina.

3 (b84) Choose Life. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for a "Choose
4 Life" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money
5 in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "Choose Life"
6 plates to the Carolina Pregnancy Care Fellowship, which shall distribute the money annually to
7 nongovernmental, not-for-profit agencies that provide pregnancy services that are limited to
8 counseling and/or meeting the physical needs of pregnant women. Funds received pursuant to
9 this section shall not be distributed to any agency, organization, business, or other entity that
10 provides, promotes, counsels, or refers for abortion and shall not be distributed to any entity
11 that charges women for services received.

12 (b85) Coastal Land Trust. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
13 "Coastal Land Trust" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer
14 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
15 sale of the "Coastal Land Trust" plates to the North Carolina Coastal Land Trust to be used to
16 acquire open space and natural areas, to ensure conservation education, to promote good land
17 stewardship, to set aside lands for conservation, and for other administrative and operating
18 costs.

19 (b86) Concerned Bikers Association/ABATE of North Carolina. – The Division must
20 receive 300 or more applications for the "Concerned Bikers Association/ABATE of North
21 Carolina" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the
22 money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of the
23 "Concerned Bikers Association/ABATE of North Carolina" plates to the Department of Public
24 Instruction to support the driver training and safety education program established pursuant to
25 G.S. 115C-215 and to support motorcycle safety and awareness training as part of the driver
26 training program.

27 (b87) Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden. – The Division must receive 300 or more
28 applications for the "Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden" plate before the plate may be developed.
29 The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate
30 Account derived from the sale of "Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden" plates to the Daniel Stowe
31 Botanical Garden Foundation, Inc., to provide funding for the Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden
32 outreach program.

33 (b88) Donate Life. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the "Donate
34 Life" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money
35 in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "Donate Life"
36 plates to Donate Life North Carolina to be divided equally among Donate Life North Carolina
37 and each of the transplant centers in North Carolina to include Bowman Gray Medical Center,
38 Carolinas Medical Center, Duke University, East Carolina University, and the University of
39 North Carolina at Chapel Hill. The transplant centers shall use all of the proceeds received from
40 this plate to provide funding for expenses incurred by needy families, recipients, and expenses
41 related to organ donation.

42 (b89) Farmland Preservation. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
43 the "Farmland Preservation" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must
44 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
45 from the sale of "Farmland Preservation" plates to the North Carolina Agricultural
46 Development and Farmland Preservation Trust Fund established pursuant to G.S. 106-744.

47 (b90) First in Turf. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the "First in
48 Turf" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money
49 in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "First in Turf"
50 plates to the Center for Environmental Turfgrass Research at North Carolina State University
51 for its programs.

1 (b91) Girl Scouts. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the "Girl
2 Scouts" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the
3 money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "Girl
4 Scouts" plates to the Girl Scouts North Carolina Coastal Pines, where the proceeds will be
5 divided equally among the officially chartered Girl Scout Councils in this State to be used for
6 educational programs, preservation programs, capital improvements on facilities located in this
7 State, and related administrative and operating expenses.

8 (b92) Home of American Golf. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
9 the "Home of American Golf" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must
10 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
11 from the sale of "Home of American Golf" plates to the Given Memorial Library, Inc., to
12 provide funding for the Given Memorial Library – The Tufts Archives.

13 (b93) Jaycees. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the "Jaycees"
14 plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the
15 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "Jaycees" plates to
16 the North Carolina JCI Senate, Inc., to be used to support and underwrite Jaycee activities in
17 North Carolina.

18 (b94) Mountains-to-Sea Trail. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
19 the "Mountains-to-Sea Trail" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall
20 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
21 from the sale of "Mountains-to-Sea Trail" plates to the Friends of the Mountains-to-Sea Trail,
22 Inc., to be used to fund trail projects and related administrative and operating expenses.

23 (b95) NC Beekeepers. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the "NC
24 Beekeepers" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the
25 money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "NC
26 Beekeepers" plates to North Carolina State University for research on the importance of bees to
27 agriculture and the State's agricultural economy.

28 (b96) NC Civil War. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the "NC
29 Civil War" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the
30 money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "NC
31 Civil War" plates to the North Carolina Department of Cultural Resources, Division of
32 Archives and History, to provide funding to acquire, interpret, and preserve North Carolina's
33 Civil War history.

34 (b97) NC Fisheries Association. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
35 a "NC Fisheries Association" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must
36 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
37 from the sale of "NC Fisheries Association" plates to the NC Fisheries Association to facilitate
38 the promotion of North Carolina families, heritage, and seafood through accessible data about
39 the ever-changing commercial fishing industry.

40 (b98) NC Horse Council. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
41 "NC Horse Council" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer
42 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
43 sale of "NC Horse Council" plates to the North Carolina Horse Council, Inc., to promote and
44 enhance the equine industry in North Carolina.

45 (b99) NC Mining. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the "NC
46 Mining" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the
47 money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "NC
48 Mining" plates to the North Carolina Gold Foundation, Inc., to provide funding for information
49 and education about mining in North Carolina.

50 (b100) NC Veterinary Medical Association. – The Division must receive 300 or more
51 applications for the "NC Veterinary Medical Association" plate before the plate may be

1 developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural
2 Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "NC Veterinary Medical Association" plates
3 to the Friends of NCVMA Foundation, Inc., to be used to provide compassionate, quality health
4 care for all animals, to protect the health of the public, to strengthen the human-animal bond,
5 and to provide advanced continuing education for the public.

6 (b101) NC Victim Assistance Network. – The Division must receive 300 or more
7 applications for a "NC Victim Assistance Network" plate before the plate may be developed.
8 The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate
9 Account derived from the sale of "NC Victim Assistance Network" plates to the NC Victim
10 Assistance Network to support the mission of the NC Victim Assistance Network to provide
11 support and information for crime victims across the State and to advocate for their fair
12 treatment.

13 (b102) NC Wildlife Federation. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
14 the "NC Wildlife Federation" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall
15 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
16 from the sale of "NC Wildlife Federation" plates to the North Carolina Wildlife Federation,
17 Inc., to provide funding for a grassroots program to involve anglers, hunters, and wildlife
18 enthusiasts in conservation issues affecting North Carolina.

19 (b103) North Carolina Emergency Management Association. – The Division must receive
20 300 or more applications for the "North Carolina Emergency Management Association" plate
21 before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the
22 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "North Carolina
23 Emergency Management Association" plates to the North Carolina Emergency Management
24 Association to be used for training and education purposes.

25 (b104) North Carolina Master Gardener. – The Division must receive 300 or more
26 applications for the "North Carolina Master Gardener" plate before the plate may be developed.
27 The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate
28 Account derived from the sale of "North Carolina Master Gardener" plates to the Master
29 Gardener's Endowment Fund maintained by the Agricultural Foundation of North Carolina
30 State University, to be used for educational programs by trained volunteers who work in
31 partnership with their county Cooperative Extension offices to extend information in consumer
32 horticulture.

33 (b105) Outer Banks Preservation Association. – The Division must receive 300 or more
34 applications for an "Outer Banks Preservation Association" plate before the plate may be
35 developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural
36 Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "Outer Banks Preservation Association"
37 plates to the Outer Banks Preservation Association to facilitate the protection of the public's
38 right to access beaches in North Carolina.

39 (b106) Pamlico-Tar River Foundation. – The Division must receive 300 or more
40 applications for the "Pamlico-Tar River Foundation" plate before the plate may be developed.
41 The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate
42 Account derived from the sale of "Pamlico-Tar River Foundation" plates to the Pamlico-Tar
43 River Foundation, Inc., to provide funding for the cleanup, preservation, and oversight of the
44 Pamlico and Tar Rivers, and their watersheds and basins.

45 (b107) P.E.O. Sisterhood. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
46 "P.E.O. Sisterhood" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer
47 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
48 sale of "P.E.O. Sisterhood" plates to P.E.O. International to be used for scholarships for young
49 women.

50 (b108) Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
51 the "Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall

1 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
2 from the sale of "Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity" plates to the Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc., to
3 provide funding for scholarships, education and professional development, or similar programs.
4 None of the proceeds from this special plate may be distributed to any board member as
5 compensation or as an honorarium.

6 (b109) Piedmont Airlines. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for a
7 "Piedmont Airlines" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer
8 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
9 sale of "Piedmont Airlines" plates to Piedmont Silver Eagles Charitable Funds, Inc., to be used
10 for scholarships and family assistance for Piedmont Airlines employees and their families,
11 including surviving spouses and dependents, suffering economic hardship.

12 (b110) Ronald McDonald House. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
13 the "Ronald McDonald House" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall
14 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
15 from the sale of "Ronald McDonald House" plates to Ronald McDonald House Charities of
16 North Carolina, Inc., to be used for Ronald McDonald Houses located within North Carolina
17 and related administrative and operating expenses.

18 (b111) S.T.A.R. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the "S.T.A.R."
19 plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the
20 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "S.T.A.R." plates to
21 Save the Animals Rescue, Inc., to provide funding to rescue distressed horses.

22 (b112) Support NC Education. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
23 the "Support NC Education" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall
24 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
25 from the sale of "Support NC Education" plates to the Board of Governors of The University of
26 North Carolina to be used to provide scholarship funding at the 16 constituent universities of
27 The University of North Carolina.

28 (b113) Support Soccer. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
29 "Support Soccer" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly
30 the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of
31 "Support Soccer" plates to the North Carolina Soccer Hall of Fame, Inc., to provide funding to
32 promote the sport of soccer in North Carolina.

33 (b114) Toastmasters Club. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
34 "Toastmasters Club" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer
35 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
36 sale of the "Toastmasters Club" plates to Toastmasters International to be used to help North
37 Carolinians communicate more effectively, improve presentation skills, and develop leadership
38 potential.

39 (b115) Topsail Island Shoreline Protection. – The Division must receive 300 or more
40 applications for the "Topsail Island Shoreline Protection" plate before the plate may be
41 developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural
42 Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "Topsail Island Shoreline Protection " plates
43 proportionately to the Town of North Topsail Beach, the Town of Surf City, and the Town of
44 Topsail Beach to be used for support of the Topsail Island Shoreline Protection Committee and
45 beach nourishment programs or projects for the three towns on Topsail Island.

46 (b116) Travel and Tourism. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
47 "Travel and Tourism" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer
48 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
49 sale of "Travel and Tourism" plates to the Division of Tourism, Film, and Sports Development
50 to be used for programs in support of travel and tourism in North Carolina."

1 **SECTION 8.** Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
2 section to read:

3 **"§ 20-79.8. Expiration of special registration plate authorization.**

4 (a) Expiration. – A special registration plate authorized pursuant to G.S. 20-79.4 shall
5 expire, as a matter of law, on July 1 of the second calendar year following the year in which the
6 special plate was authorized if the number of required applications for the authorized special
7 plate has not been received by the Division. The Division shall not accept applications for nor
8 advertise any special registration plate that has expired pursuant to this section.

9 (b) Notification. – The Division shall notify the Revisor of Statutes in writing, not later
10 than July 15 of each year, which special registration plate authorizations have expired as a
11 matter of law pursuant to subsection (a) of this section. The Division shall publish a copy of the
12 written notification sent to the Revisor of Statutes pursuant to this subsection on a Web site
13 maintained by the Division or the Department of Transportation.

14 (c) Revisor of Statutes Responsibilities. – Upon notification of expiration of the
15 authorization for any special registration plate by the Division pursuant to this section, the
16 Revisor of Statutes shall verify that the authorization for each special registration plate listed
17 has expired and shall notate such expiration in the applicable statutes. If an authorization for a
18 special registration plate listed in G.S. 20-79.4 expires, the Revisor of Statutes shall revise the
19 subdivision referring to the special registration plate to leave the name of the special
20 registration plate authorized and the date the special registration plate's authorization expired. If
21 an authorization for a special registration plate listed in G.S. 20-79.4 expires, the Revisor of
22 Statutes shall also make corresponding changes to reflect the expiration of the special
23 registration plate's authorization, if applicable, in G.S. 20-63(b), 20-79.7, and 20-81.12."

24 **SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding Section 8 of this act, any special registration plate
25 authorized in G.S. 20-79.7, prior to July 1, 2011, shall expire, as a matter of law, on July 1,
26 2013, if the number of applications required for the production of the special registration plate
27 has not been received by the Division of Motor Vehicles on or before that date. Upon
28 notification of expiration of the authorization for any special plate by the Division pursuant to
29 this section, the Revisor of Statutes shall verify that the authorization for each special
30 registration plate listed has expired and shall notate such expiration in the applicable statutes. If
31 an authorization for a special registration plate listed in G.S. 20-79.4 expires, the Revisor of
32 Statutes shall revise the subdivision referring to the special registration plate to leave the name
33 of the special plate authorized and the date the special registration plate's authorization expired.
34 If an authorization for a special registration plate listed in G.S. 20-79.4 expires, the Revisor of
35 Statutes shall also make corresponding changes to reflect the expiration of the special
36 registration plate's authorization, if applicable, in G.S. 20-63(b), 20-79.7, and 20-81.12.

37 **SECTION 10.** The Revisor of Statutes is authorized to alphabetize, number, and
38 renumber the special registration plates listed in G.S. 20-79.4 to ensure that all the special
39 registration plates are listed in alphabetical order and numbered accordingly.

40 **SECTION 11.** Section 8 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2011. The remainder
41 of this act is effective when it becomes law.
