8 (1) Shall furnish pathological materials and medical records requested under this  
9 section within 30 days of the receipt of the request.  
10 (2) May charge a reasonable fee pursuant to G.S. 90-411.  
11 (3) Shall transfer any pathological materials in accordance with best medical  
12 practices.  
13 (4) Shall not release any pathological materials in a manner which would  
14 endanger the public health or safety or violate applicable laws and  
15 regulations relating to the safe handling and transfer of pathological  
16 materials.";

18 and on page 1, lines 24 – 25, by inserting between the lines the following:

20 "(e) Nothing in this section shall be construed to change or interfere with the best practices  
21 and accepted medical standards of the health care provider.";
