The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. Notwithstanding G.S. 143-128, 143-129, 143-131, 143-132,
143-64.31, and 143-64.32, Wayne County may use the design-build method of construction for
the construction or renovation of buildings owned by the County. The County shall seek to
prequalify and solicit at least three design-build teams to bid on the project and shall receive at
least three sealed proposals from those teams for each project. The proposals shall not require
the design-build team to submit project design solutions. If three proposals are not received and
the project has been publicly advertised for a minimum of 30 days, the County may proceed

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes, Currituck County may contract for the construction or renovation of buildings owned by the County. The County shall award the contract to the best qualified contractor, taking into consideration in its selection the time of completion of the project and the cost of the project.
