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1	(d) When the Board issues a license to a business entity or a foreign entity under this
2	section, the Board shall indicate on the license the name and license number of the individual
3	licensee required under subsection (a) of this section.
4	(e) The individual licensee required under subsection (a) of this section shall exercise
5	direct supervision over a contract by a business entity or a foreign entity for irrigation
6	construction or irrigation contracting until the contract is completed.
7	(f) An individual licensed under this Chapter may not execute a contract for irrigation
8	construction or irrigation contracting on behalf of a business entity or a foreign entity unless the
9	business entity or foreign entity is licensed under this section.
10	(g) All of the following shall apply if the individual licensee required under subsection
11	(a) of this section ceases to be an officer, full-time employee, manager, executive, general
12	partner, or owner of the business entity or foreign entity licensed under this section:
13	(1) The business entity or foreign entity shall provide written notice to the Board
14	pursuant to rules adopted by the Board.
15	(2) The business entity or foreign entity must satisfy the requirements of
16	subsection (a) of this section within 90 days of the effective date of the
17	notice required under subdivision (1) of this subsection.
18	The Board shall suspend the license of a business entity or foreign entity licensed under this
19	section that fails after 90 days to satisfy the requirements of subsection (a) of this section."
20	SECTION 5. G.S. 89G-9 reads as rewritten:
21	"§ 89G-9. License renewal and continuing education.
22	(a) Every license issued under this Chapter shall be renewed on or before December 31
23 24	of each year. Any person who desires to continue to practice <u>irrigation contracting or irrigation</u> <u>construction</u> shall apply for license renewal and shall submit the required fees. Licenses that are
24 25	not renewed shall be automatically revoked. A license may be renewed at any time within one
23 26	year after its expiration, if: (i) the applicant pays the required renewal fee and late renewal fee;
20 27	(ii) the Board finds that the applicant has not used the license in a manner inconsistent with the
28	provisions of this Chapter or engaged in the practice of irrigation construction or contracting
29	after notice of revocation; and (iii) the applicant is otherwise eligible for licensure under the
30	provisions of this Chapter. When necessary, the Board may require a licensee to demonstrate
31	continued competence as a condition of license renewal.
32	(b) As a condition of license renewal, <u>a an individual licensee shall meet continuing</u>
33	education requirements set by the Board. Each individual licensee shall complete 10 continuing
34	education units per year. Failure to obtain continuing education units shall result in the
35	forfeiture of a license.
36	(c) The Board shall suspend an individual licensee's license for 60 days for failure to
37	obtain continuing education units required by subsection (b) of this section. The Board shall
38	suspend a business entity's or a foreign entity's license for 60 days for failure by the individual
39	licensee required under G.S. 89G-6.1(a) to obtain continuing education units required by
40	subsection (b) of this section. Upon completion of the required continuing education and
41	payment of the reinstatement fee, the Board shall reinstate the license. Failure by an individual
42	licensee to meet the education requirements, to request a reinstatement of the license, or to pay
43	the reinstatement fee within the time provided shall result in the forfeiture of the license. Upon
44	forfeiture, a personan individual shall be required to submit a new application and retake the
45	examination as provided in this Chapter."
