of 2 P.M. and 8 P.M. on any day the sale of spirituous liquor is authorized at an ABC store by G.S. 18B-802. With respect to spirituous liquor, a permittee may sell no more than two liters per product label produced on site by the distillery in a single business day to any patron participating in a tour. In addition to the two liters per product label produced on site by the distillery, as authorized by this subdivision, a permittee may sell up to four 50 ml bottles of spirituous liquor in a single business day to any patron participating in a tour. The Commission shall adopt rules regulating the retail sale of spirituous liquor at distilleries.

(b) Distilleries for Fuel Alcohol. – Any person in possession of a Federal Operating Permit pursuant to Title 27, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 201.64 through 201.65 or Part 201.131 through 201.138 shall obtain a fuel alcohol permit before manufacturing any alcohol. The permit shall entitle the permittee to perform only those acts allowed by the Federal Operating Permit, and all conditions of the Federal Operating Permit shall apply to the State permit."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2011.

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
