1 moves to amend the bill on page 16, lines 10-12 by rewriting the lines to read:

3 "appropriate and adequate for that purpose. Elementary education (K-6) teachers shall also
4 achieve a prescribed minimum score on subtests or standard examination specific to teaching
5 reading and mathematics. Beginning July 1, 2014, individuals seeking to obtain an elementary
6 education or special education teaching license shall be required to achieve a prescribed
7 minimum score on the North Carolina Foundations of Reading test to assess proficiencies in the
8 foundations of reading development, development of reading comprehension, reading
9 assessment, and reading instruction. The State Board of Education shall permit an applicant to
10 fulfill any";

12 And on page 17, lines 39-40 by rewriting the lines to read:

14 **"SECTION 8.(b)** The State Board of Education shall develop a North Carolina
15 Foundations of Reading test to assess proficiencies in the foundations of reading development,
16 development of reading comprehension, reading assessment, and reading instruction, such as
17 the Massachusetts Foundations of Reading test. This section is effective when it becomes law
18 and applies beginning with the 2013-2014 school year."
