Beginning July 1, 2014, individuals seeking to obtain an elementary education or special education teaching license shall be required to achieve a prescribed minimum score on the North Carolina Foundations of Reading test to assess proficiencies in the foundations of reading development, development of reading comprehension, reading assessment, and reading instruction. The State Board of Education shall permit an applicant to fulfill any";

14 15 16 17	"SECTION 8.(b) The State Board of Education shall develop a North Carolina Foundations of Reading test to assess proficiencies in the foundations of reading development, development of reading comprehension, reading assessment, and reading instruction, such as the Massachusetts Foundations of Reading test. This section is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 2013-2014 school year."
