Senator Stein

moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 2-12, as amended by Amendment #2, by rewriting the lines to read:

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"AN ACT TO MAKE CHANGES TO IMPROVE K-3 LITERACY; PROVIDE LITERACY VOLUNTEER LEAVE TIME; DIRECT THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO DEVELOP A NEW MODEL FOR MEASURING SCHOOL PERFORMANCE; MAXIMIZE INSTRUCTIONAL TIME; PROVIDE FOR THREE PROTECTED TEACHER WORKDAYS; FUND FIVE ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONAL DAYS WITHIN THE EXISTING SCHOOL CALENDAR; ESTABLISH AN NC TEACHER CORPS; STRENGTHEN TEACHER LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS; ESTABLISH PLANS FOR PAY FOR EXCELLENCE; CLARIFY NC PRE-K PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY AND ADD SLOTS; REPEAL PROHIBITION ON TEACHER PREPAYMENT; PROVIDE A TAX DEDUCTION FOR EDUCATIONAL SUPPLIES; AND DIRECT THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO REPORT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NEW DISMISSAL HEARINGS PROCESS AND EVALUATION PROCESS FOR TEACHERS AS REQUIRED BY S.L. 2011-348.";

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And on page 4, lines 39-40 by inserting between the lines the following:

19 20 21 "(6) Students whose principal decides that retention is not in the student's best interest.";

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And on page 7, lines 47-48 by inserting between the lines the following:

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"f. Students whose principal decides that retention is not in the student's best interest.";

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And on page 9, line 13 through page 11, line 46, by rewriting those lines to read:

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"PART III. NEW MODEL FOR MEASURING SCHOOL PERFORMANCE

SECTION 3.(a) The State Board of Education shall develop a new model for measuring school performance that gives parents and educators more relevant and clear information about how well schools are preparing students for college, work, and adulthood.



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The new accountability model shall reflect: (1) performance and status based on student proficiency; (2) progress of schools based on annual measurable objectives; and (3) school-level growth metrics using Education Value Added Assessment System (EVAAS) results. The State Board shall report results from this new model for the State and for each local school administrative unit in the annual report card required by G.S. 115C-12(9)c1.

SECTION 3.(b) This section is effective when it becomes law.";

And on page 12, line 38 through page 14, line 42, as amended by Amendment #2, by rewriting the lines to read:

"PART V. PROTECTED TEACHER WORKDAYS

SECTION 5.(a) G.S. 115C-84.2(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

- "(a) School Calendar. Each local board of education shall adopt a school calendar consisting of 215 days all of which shall fall within the fiscal year. A school calendar shall include the following:
 - Three days, as designated by the local board, for use as teacher workdays.

 These days shall be protected to allow teachers to complete instructional and classroom administrative duties. The local school administrative unit shall not impose any additional tasks on these days. The local board shall schedule at least one of these days at the beginning of the school year and at least one at the end of the school year.

SECTION 5.(b) This section is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 2013-2014 school year.";

And on page 17, line 42, through page 18, line 8, by deleting those lines;

And on page 18, lines 10-33 by deleting those lines and substituting the following:

"PART X. PAY FOR EXCELLENCE

SECTION 10.(a) Local boards of education may develop a plan of performance pay for all licensed personnel employed by them after consulting with teachers and administrators for the State Board of Education to consider. Under the performance pay plan, licensed employees should be eligible to receive bonuses or adjustments to base salary for meeting certain performance criteria. Criteria for award of bonuses or adjustments to base salary in any proposed plan should include, but are not limited to, the following factors:

- (1) Annual growth in student achievement of students assigned to a teacher's classroom, when applicable.
- (2) Annual growth in student achievement of students assigned to a specific school.
- (3) Assignment of additional academic responsibilities.

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- (4)Assignment to a hard-to-staff school.
- Assignment to a hard-to-staff subject area. (5)

If a local board of education decides to develop a plan of performance pay, it shall submit the plan to the State Board of Education no later than March 1, 2013. The State Board of Education shall consider the plans submitted by the local boards of education and report on the submitted plans and the achievement-based compensation models developed as part of the federal Race to the Top grant. The State Board shall submit the comprehensive report and all plans to the Fiscal Research Division, the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations, and the respective Subcommittees on Education Appropriations of the Senate and House of Representatives no later than April 15, 2013. Members of the public may also submit plans for performance pay no later than April 15, 2013, to the Fiscal Research Division, the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations, and the respective Subcommittees on Education Appropriations of the Senate and House of Representatives.

SECTION 10.(b) This section is effective when it becomes law.";

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And on page 19, line 39 through page 41, line 7, by deleting those lines and substituting the following:

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"PART XIV. REPORT ON TEACHER DISMISSAL HEARING PROCESS AND **EVALUATION PROCESS**

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SECTION 14.(a) The State Board of Education shall report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee on the implementation and outcomes of the new dismissal hearing process and evaluation process for teachers as required by S.L. 2011-348. The report shall be submitted by October 15, 2013.

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SECTION 14.(b) This section is effective when it becomes law.".
