A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REALIGN THE DISTRICTS FOR WAKE COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT
JUDGE SEATS TO PROVIDE FOR SINGLE MEMBER DISTRICTS AND EQUAL
REPRESENTATION IN THOSE DISTRICTS, WHICH ARE TO BE DETERMINED.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-41(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) The counties of the State are organized into judicial divisions and superior court districts, and each superior court district has the counties, and the number of regular resident superior court judges set forth in the following table, and for districts of less than a whole county, as set out in subsection (b) of this section:

30 is not in Superior Court Districts 5A or 5B. It has one judge."

31 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 7A-41(c)(2a) reads as rewritten:

32 "(2a) For Wake County, ~~the precincts are as they were adopted by the Wake~~
33 ~~County Board of Elections and in effect as of January 1, 2001; the names and~~
34 ~~boundaries of voting tabulation districts and blocks specified in this section~~
35 are as shown on the 2010 Census Redistricting TIGER/Line Shapefiles."

36 **SECTION 4.** The judgeships established for Wake County Superior Court, as
37 created by Sections 1 and 2 of this act, shall be filled as follows, according to district:

- 38 (1) District 10A, by Michael R. Morgan whose term expires on December 31,
39 2012.
- 40 (2) District 10B, by Paul C. Ridgeway whose term expires on December 31,
41 2014.
- 42 (3) District 10C, by Paul G. Gessner whose term expires on December 31, 2014.
- 43 (4) District 10D, by Donald Stephens whose term expires on December 31,
44 2012.
- 45 (5) District 10E, by Abraham P. Jones whose term expires on December 31,
46 2012.
- 47 (6) District 10F, by Howard E. Manning, Jr., whose term expires December 31,
48 2016.

49 **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2013, and applies to the 2012
50 election.
