Senator Goolsby

1 moves to amend the bill on page 2, line 20-43, by rewriting the lines to read:

2 "k. Is licensed to practice as a dental hygienist under Article 16 of this
3 Chapter.

4 l. Holds a license as a registered licensed optician under Article 17 of
5 this Chapter.

6 m. Is licensed to practice as a physician, physician assistant, dentist,
7 pharmacist, optometrist, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse,
8 dental hygienist, or optician under provisions of law of another state
9 of the United States comparable to the provisions referenced in
10 sub-subdivisions a. through n. of this subdivision.

11 (4) Sponsoring organization. – Any nonprofit organization that organizes or
12 arranges for the voluntary provision of health care services pursuant to this
13 Article.

14 (5) Voluntary provision of health care services. – The provision of health care
15 services by a health care provider in association with a sponsoring
16 organization in which both of the following circumstances exist:

17 a. The health care services are provided without charge to the recipient
18 of the services or to a third party on behalf of the recipient.

19 b. The health care provider receives no compensation or other
20 consideration in exchange for the health care services provided.

21 For the purposes of this Article, the provision of health care services in
22 non-profit community health centers, local health department facilities, free
23 clinic facilities, or at a providers place of employment when the patient is
24 referred by a non-profit community health referral service shall not be
25 considered the voluntary provision of health care.";

27 And on page 3, line 23, by deleting the phrase "By no later than 20 days" and substituting the
28 phrase "Except as provided in this subdivision, by no later than 14 days";
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1 And on page 3, lines 35-36, by adding the following between the lines:
2 "By no later than 3 days prior to voluntary health care services being rendered, a sponsoring
3 organization may amend the list to add health care providers defined in G.S. 90-21.102 (3)a.
4 through G.S. 90-21.102 (3)m."
5

6 And on page 4 line 25, by rewriting the line to read:
7 "health care services is occurring. In addition, every sponsoring organization shall post in a
8 clear and conspicuous manner the following notice in the premises where the provision of
9 voluntary health care services is occurring:

10 **NOTICE**

11 Under North Carolina law, there is no liability for damages for injuries or death alleged to have
12 occurred by reason of an act or omission in the health care provider's voluntary provision of
13 health care services, unless it is established that the injuries or death were caused by gross
14 negligence, wanton conduct, or intentional wrongdoing on the part of the health care
15 provider."
