1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO MAKE STATEWIDE THE AUTHORITY PREVIOUSLY GRANTED TO
3	NASH COUNTY SO AS TO ALLOW COUNTIES TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO
4	PROMOTE HIGH-SPEED INTERNET ACCESS SERVICE IN UNSERVED AREAS
5	FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND TO MAKE OTHER CLARIFYING
6	CHANGES.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Section 1 of S.L. 2011-163 reads as rewritten:
9	"SECTION 1. A county may provide grants to unaffiliated qualified private providers of
10	high-speed Internet broadband access service, as that term is defined in G.S. 160A-340(4), for
11	the purpose of expanding service in unserved areas for economic development in the county.
12	The grants shall be awarded on a technology neutral basis, shall be open to qualified applicants,
13	and may require matching funds by the private provider. A county shall seek and consider
14	request for proposals from qualified private providers within the county prior to awarding a
15	broadband grant and shall use reasonable means to ensure that potential applicants are made
16	aware of the grant, including, at a minimum, compliance with the notice procedures set forth in
17	<u>G.S. 160A-340.6(c)</u> . The county shall use only unrestricted general fund revenue for the grants.
18	For the purposes of this section, a qualified private provider is a private provider of high-speed
19	Internet access service in the State prior to the issuance of the grant proposal."
20	SECTION 2. Section 3 of S.L. 2011-163 is repealed.
21	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law. Section 1 of this act shall
22	not apply to any broadband grant process initiated by Nash County prior to June 1, 2012.



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
