6		TION 1. The State Auditor shall conduct an investigative audit of the Roanoke	
7		ion, which is a State commission that receives State funds. As part of its	
8	investigation, the Auditor shall carefully examine all funds that have been received by Friends		
9	of Elizabeth II, Inc., (Friends) from the Roanoke Island Commission or any other State entity,		
10	regardless of the characterization by any party of the nature of a transfer, and determine the		
11	following:		
12	(1)	The balance of such funds still held by the Friends.	
13	(2)	The interest earned on such funds and the rate of interest on such funds, both	
14		as of the time of the audit and over the period in which the Friends have held	
15		such funds.	
16	(3)	The expenditure of funds received by the Friends from the Roanoke Island	
17		Commission or any other State entity.	
18	(4)	Whether such funds have been used by the Friends for the purposes for	
19		which they were transferred.	
20	(5)	Whether such funds were properly transferred by State entities to the Friends	
21		in accordance with the law.	
22	(6)	Whether the use of such funds has been properly reported in accordance with	
23		the law.	
24	The A	Auditor shall make recommendations based on the Auditor's findings and shall	
25	publish a report describing all issues investigated, a summary of the contents of documents		
26	examined and interviews conducted, all other findings, and the recommendations.		
27	As part of its audit, the Auditor shall also review any memorandums of agreement,		
28	or similar arrangements, between the Roanoke Island Commission and the Friends and shall		
29	make recommendations as to what should be included in such an agreement between the		
30	Roanoke Island Commission and the Friends.
