11 **SECTION 1.1** If Senate Bill 820 becomes law, then, effective August 1, 2012,
12 G.S. 143B-293.2(a), as enacted by Section 1.(b) of Senate Bill 820, reads as rewritten:

13 "(a) Members Selection. – The North Carolina Mining and Energy Commission shall
14 consist of 15 members appointed as follows:

- 15 (1) The Chair of the North Carolina State University Minerals Research
16 Laboratory Advisory Committee, or the Chair's designee, ex officio.
- 17 (2) The State Geologist, or the State Geologist's designee, ex officio.
- 18 (3) The Assistant Secretary of Energy for the Department of Commerce, ex
19 officio.
- 20 (4) One appointed by the General Assembly upon recommendation of the
21 Speaker of the House of Representatives who is a member of a
22 nongovernmental conservation interest.
- 23 (5) One appointed by the General Assembly upon recommendation of the
24 Speaker of the House of Representatives who is an elected official of a
25 municipal government located in the Triassic Basin of North Carolina.
- 26 (6) One appointed by the General Assembly upon recommendation of the
27 Speaker of the House of Representatives who is a member of the
28 Environmental Management Commission and knowledgeable in the
29 principles of water and air resources management.One appointed by the
30 General Assembly upon recommendation of the Speaker of the House of
31 Representatives who is a representative of the mining industry.
