10 And on page 9, lines 34 – 35, by inserting the following new section between the lines:

12 **"SECTION 15.3.** G.S. 143-138.1 reads as rewritten:

13 **"§ 143-138.1. Introduction and instruction of the North Carolina Building Code.**

14 (a) Prior to the effective date of Code changes pursuant to G.S. 143-138, the State
 15 Building Code Council and Department of Insurance shall provide for instructional classes for
 16 the various trades affected by the Code. The Department of Insurance shall develop the
 17 curriculum for each class but shall consult the affected licensing boards and trade
 18 organizations. The curriculum shall include explanations of the rationale and need for each
 19 Code amendment or revision. Classes may also be conducted by, on behalf of, or in cooperation
 20 with licensing boards, trade associations, and professional societies. The Department of
 21 Insurance may charge fees sufficient to recover the costs it incurs under this ~~section~~
 22 subsection. The Council shall ensure that courses are accessible to persons throughout the
 23 State.

24 (b) At least 30 days prior to the effective date of Code changes pursuant to G.S. 143-
 25 138, the State Building Code Council and Department of Insurance Office of State Fire
 26 Marshall Engineering Division staff shall provide instructional classes for code enforcement
 27 officials. The Department of Insurance Office of State Fire Marshall Engineering Division staff
 28 shall develop and present the curriculum for each class. The curriculum shall explain each
 29 Code amendment or revision. The Building Code Council shall ensure that courses are
 30 accessible to persons by online presentation or by at least six regional classes. Copies of the
 31 entire code documents adopted by the State Building Code Council and approved by the Rules


