 2 " **REPORTING OF POSITION ELIMINATIONS**

3 **SECTION 29.22A.** The Office of State Personnel, the Administrative Officer of
 4 the Courts, the Legislative Services Officer, the Department of Public Instruction, the North
 5 Carolina Community Colleges System Office and the University of North Carolina – General
 6 Administration shall report to the Fiscal Research Division no later than May 1, 2012 position
 7 eliminations during fiscal year 2011-2012 as follows:

- 8 (1) For the Office of State Personnel, the total numbers of SPA and EPA
 9 position eliminations in the State agencies, departments, institutions, boards
 10 and commissions directly attributable to funding reductions imposed by this
 11 Act including, by funding source, the number filled versus vacant, the annual
 12 salary savings, the total annual savings (including employer benefits costs),
 13 total severance wages paid, total discontinued service retirement allowance
 14 costs paid, and the total projected employer paid health benefit coverage
 15 premiums to be paid during fiscal year 2011-2012 for employees
 16 reduced-in-force as provided by G.S. 135-45.2(a)(8).
- 17 (2) For the Administrative Officer of the Courts, the total number of position
 18 eliminations in the Judicial Branch directly attributable to funding reductions
 19 imposed by this Act including, by funding source, the number filled versus
 20 vacant, the annual salary savings, the total annual savings (including
 21 employer benefits costs), total severance wages paid, total discontinued
 22 service retirement allowance costs paid, and the total projected employer
 23 paid health benefit coverage premiums to be paid during fiscal year
 24 2011-2012 for employees reduced-in-force as provided by
 25 G.S. 135-45.2(a)(8).
- 26 (3) For the Legislative Services Officer, the total number of position
 27 eliminations in the Legislative Branch directly attributable to funding
 28 reductions imposed by this Act including the number filled versus vacant,
 29 the annual salary savings, the total annual savings (including employer
 30 benefits costs), total severance wages paid, total discontinued service
 31 retirement allowance costs paid, and the total projected employer paid health
 32 benefit coverage premiums to be paid during fiscal year 2011-2012 for
 33 employees reduced-in-force as provided by G.S. 135-45.2(a)(8).



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- 1 (4) For the Department of Public Instruction, the total number of General Fund
2 supported position eliminations in the local school administrative units
3 directly attributable to funding reductions imposed by this Act including the
4 number filled versus vacant, the annual salary savings, the total annual
5 savings (including employer benefits costs), and the total projected employer
6 paid health benefit coverage premiums to be paid during fiscal year
7 2011-2012 for employees reduced-in-force as provided by
8 G.S. 135-45.2(a)(8).
- 9 (5) For the North Carolina Community Colleges System Office, the total
10 number of General Fund supported position eliminations in the local
11 community college institutions directly attributable to funding reductions
12 imposed by this Act including the number filled versus vacant, the annual
13 salary savings, the total annual savings (including employer benefits costs),
14 and the total projected employer paid health benefit coverage premiums to
15 be paid during fiscal year 2011-2012 for employees reduced-in-force as
16 provided by G.S. 135-45.2(a)(8).
- 17 (6) For the University of North Carolina – General Administration, the total
18 numbers of SPA, EPA non-faculty and EPA faculty position eliminations in
19 the constituent institutions directly attributable to funding reductions
20 imposed by this Act including, by funding source, the number filled versus
21 vacant, the annual salary savings, the total annual savings (including
22 employer benefits costs), total severance wages paid, total discontinued
23 service retirement allowance costs paid, and the total projected employer
24 paid health benefit coverage premiums to be paid during fiscal year
25 2011-2012 for employees reduced-in-force as provided by
26 G.S. 135-45.2(a)(8)."
