5 RULES TO SMALL WASTEWATER DISCHARGES; (8) DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT  
6 OF ENVIRONMENT";

8 and on page 8, lines 32 and 33,  
9 by inserting between those lines:

11 "SECTION 12.1 Rules adopted by the Environmental Management Commission  
12 pursuant to S.L. 2009-216 and S.L. 2009-486 to implement nutrient management strategies for  
13 the B. Everett Jordan Reservoir and the Falls of the Neuse Reservoir watersheds shall not be  
14 interpreted to apply surface water quality standards set out in 15A NCAC 2B .0218 (3)(e)  
15 through (3)(h) to waters designated in the nutrient management rules as WS-V except where:  
16 (i) the designation of WS-V is associated with a water supply intake used by an industry to  
17 supply drinking water for their employees; or (ii) standards set out in 15A NCAC 02B .0218  
18 (3)(e) through (3)(h) are violated at the upstream boundary of waters within those watersheds  
19 that are classified as WS-II, WS-III, or WS-IV. This section shall not be construed to alter the  
20 nutrient reduction requirements set out in 15A NCAC 2B .0262 (5) or 15A NCAC 2B .0275  
21 (3)."
