1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 4, by rewriting the line to read:
2 "LISTS, AND TO EXEMPT PERSONS WHO HAVE BEEN LAWFULLY SUMMONED
3 FOR JURY SERVICE FROM PAYING FERRY TOLLS TO TRAVEL TO AND FROM
4 THEIR HOMES AND THE SITE OF THAT SERVICE.";

6 and on page 5, lines 3 – 4, by adding the following between the lines:

7 "SECTION 13. G.S. 7A-312(a) reads as rewritten:

8 (a) A juror in the General Court of Justice including a petit juror, or a coroner's juror,
9 but excluding a grand juror, shall receive twelve dollars (\$12.00) for the first day of service and
10 twenty dollars (\$20.00) per day afterwards, except that if any person serves as a juror for more
11 than five days in any 24-month period, the juror shall receive forty dollars (\$40.00) per day for
12 each day of service in excess of five days. A grand juror shall receive twenty dollars (\$20.00)
13 per day. A juror required to remain overnight at the site of the trial shall be furnished adequate
14 accommodations and subsistence. If required by the presiding judge to remain in a body during
15 the trial of a case, meals shall be furnished the jurors during the period of sequestration. Jurors
16 from out of the county summoned to sit on a special venire shall receive mileage at the same
17 rate as State employees. Persons summoned as jurors shall be exempt during their period of
18 service from paying a ferry toll required under G.S. 136-82 to travel to and from their homes
19 and the site of that service."
