3 2012, is convicted of an offense listed in G.S. 135-18.10A for acts committed after December
4 1, 2012, then that member shall forfeit all benefits under this System, except for a return of
5 member contributions plus interest. If a member who is in service and has vested in this System
6 on December 1, 2012, is convicted of an offense listed in G.S. 135-18.10A for acts committed
7 after December 1, 2012, then that member is not entitled to any creditable service that accrued
8 after December 1, 2012.";

10 And on page 2, lines 40-45, by rewriting the lines to read:

11 "(x) If a member who is in service and has not vested in this System on December 1,
12 2012, is convicted of an offense listed in G.S. 126-38.5 for acts committed after December 1,
13 2012, then that member shall forfeit all benefits under this System, except for a return of
14 member contributions plus interest. If a member who is in service and has vested in this System
15 on December 1, 2012, is convicted of an offense listed in G.S. 126-38.5 for acts committed
16 after December 1, 2012, then that member is not entitled to any creditable service that accrued
17 after December 1, 2012.";

19 And on page 3, lines 22-27, by rewriting the lines to read:

20 "(j) If a member who is in service and has not vested in this System on December 1,
21 2012, is convicted of an offense listed in G.S. 135-75.1A for acts committed after December 1,
22 2012, then that member shall forfeit all benefits under this System, except for a return of
23 member contributions plus interest. If a member who is in service and has vested in this System
24 on December 1, 2012, is convicted of an offense listed in G.S. 135-75.1A for acts committed
25 after December 1, 2012, then that member is not entitled to any creditable service that accrued
26 after December 1, 2012.";

28 And on page 4, lines 5-11, by rewriting the lines to read:

29 "(g) If a member who is a present member of the General Assembly and who has not
30 vested in this System on December 1, 2012, is convicted of an offense listed in G.S. 120-4.33A
31 for acts committed after December 1, 2012, then that member shall forfeit all benefits under
32 this System, except for a return of member contributions plus interest. If a member who is a

15 **"SECTION 18.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2012, and applies to
16 offenses committed on or after that date.".
