3 "SECTION 70.1 If House Bill 950, 2012 Regular Session becomes law, then
 4 Section 26.2 of that act reads as rewritten:

5 **'WATER RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS**

6 SECTION 26.2.(a) The Department of Environment and Natural Resources shall
 7 allocate funds for water resources projects in accordance with the schedule that follows. The
 8 amounts set forth in the schedule include funds appropriated in this act for water resources
 9 projects and funds carried forward from previous fiscal years in accordance with subsection (b)
 10 of this section. These funds will provide a State match for an estimated eighty-six million three
 11 hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$86,390,000) in federal funds.
