Senator Jenkins

1 moves to amend the bill on page 290, lines 11-12, by deleting "one hundred ninety-six million  
2 eight hundred forty-nine thousand five hundred forty-two dollars (\$196,849,542) " and  
3 substituting "two hundred million eight hundred sixty-nine thousand five hundred forty-two  
4 dollars (\$200,869,542)"; and

5  
6 on page 290, line 17, be deleting "one hundred eighty-eight million two hundred nine thousand  
7 forty-nine dollars (\$188,209,049)" and substituting "two hundred eleven million seven hundred  
8 sixty-five thousand five hundred forty-two dollars (\$211,765,542)"; and

9  
10 on page 290, lines 30-35, by deleting those lines and substituting the following:

11  
12 "SECTION 28.27.(d) G.S. 20-194(a) reads as rewritten:

13 '(a) ~~All expenses~~ Expenses incurred in carrying out the provisions of this Article shall  
14 be paid out of the ~~highway fund~~. General Fund. For each fiscal year, however, the General  
15 Assembly shall transfer an amount from the Highway Fund to the General Fund equal to at  
16 least ten percent (10%) of the expected revenues for the Highway Fund for that fiscal year.  
17 Funds transferred to the General Fund in accordance with this section may be used only for the  
18 support of the State Highway Patrol.'

19 SECTION 28.27.(e) The funds transferred under subsections (a) and (b) of this  
20 section are transferred in accordance with of G.S. 20-194(a), as amended by this section."; and

22 on page 290, line 37, through page 291, line 27, by deleting those lines and substituting the  
23 following:

25 "STATE HIGHWAY PATROL FUNDING; REDUCE FUNDING TO CONTRACT  
26 RESURFACING, SYSTEM PRESERVATION, AND GENERAL MAINTENANCE  
27 RESERVE

28 SECTION 28.28.(a) In case of a conflict between the provisions of this Part and  
29 the N.C. Senate Appropriations Committee Report on the Continuation, Expansion, and Capital  
30 Budgets, dated May 31, 2011, this Part shall control.

31 SECTION 28.28.(b) Notwithstanding the N.C. Senate Appropriations Committee  
32 Report on the Continuation, Expansion, and Capital Budgets, dated May 31, 2011, the  
33 following modifications are made to budget as explained in the Committee Report:

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- 1 (1) The State Highway Patrol shall not be subject to a management flexibility  
2 reduction to achieve savings of two million three hundred twenty five  
3 thousand four hundred eighty-four dollars (\$2,325,484), recurring, in fiscal  
4 year 2011-2012 and ten million three hundred seventy-three thousand three  
5 hundred fifty dollars (\$10,373,350), recurring, in fiscal year 2012-2013, as  
6 indicated in the Committee Report.
- 7 (2) The State Highway Patrol shall not be subject to an administrative  
8 consolidation to achieve recurring savings of one million three hundred  
9 eighty thousand three hundred seventy dollars (\$1,380,370), as indicated in  
10 the Committee Report.
- 11 (3) The State Highway Patrol shall not be subject to a recurring operating funds  
12 reduction of one million four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,450,000), as  
13 indicated in the Committee Report. Instead, (i) State Highway Patrol shall be  
14 subject to a recurring operating funds reduction of five hundred ninety-three  
15 thousand two hundred twenty-seven dollars (\$543,227) in fiscal year  
16 2011-2012, nonrecurring, and (ii) the sum of six million nine hundred  
17 seventy-eight thousand eight hundred forty-one dollars (\$6,978,841),  
18 recurring, is hereby appropriated for fiscal year 2012-2013 from the General  
19 Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety, State Highway  
20 Patrol Division, to be used for operations.
- 21 (4) Of the funds appropriated to the Department of Crime Control and Public  
22 Safety, State Highway Patrol Division, for fiscal year 2012-2013 operations  
23 under subdivision (3) of this subsection, a minimum of 30% of the amount  
24 shall be used for the build-out of the Voice Interoperability Plan for  
25 Emergency Responders (VIPER) system.
- 26 (5) Notwithstanding Section 29.8(c) of this act, the salary increase provisions of  
27 G.S. 20-187.3 are suspended for the only the first year of the 2011-2013  
28 fiscal biennium.

29 **SECTION 28.28.(c)** Notwithstanding the provisions of the N.C. Senate  
30 Appropriations Committee Report on the Continuation, Expansion, and Capital Budgets dated  
31 May 31, 2011, the following changes are made to the budget as explained in the Committee  
32 Report:

- 33 (1) For fiscal year 2011-2012:
- 34 a. The increased appropriation to the Contract Resurfacing program  
35 under the Highway Fund shall be reduced one million five hundred  
36 thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) from the amount provided in the  
37 Committee Report.
- 38 b. The increased appropriation to the System Preservation program  
39 under the Highway Fund shall be reduced one million five hundred  
40 thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) from the amount provided in the  
41 Committee Report.
- 42 c. The increased appropriation to the General Maintenance Reserve  
43 under the Highway Fund shall be reduced one million twenty

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- 1 thousand dollars (\$1,020,000) from the amount provided in the  
2 Committee Report.  
3 (2) For fiscal year 2012-2013:  
4 a. The increased appropriation to the Contract Resurfacing program  
5 under the Highway Fund shall be reduced eight million five hundred  
6 thousand dollars (\$8,500,000) from the amount provided in the  
7 Committee Report.  
8 b. The increased appropriation to the System Preservation program  
9 under the Highway Fund shall be reduced eight million five hundred  
10 thousand dollars (\$8,500,000) from the amount provided in the  
11 Committee Report.  
12 c. The increased appropriation to the General Maintenance Reserve  
13 under the Highway Fund shall be reduced six million five hundred  
14 fifty-six thousand four hundred ninety-three dollars (\$6,556,493)  
15 from the amount provided in the Committee Report."; and  
16  
17 by adjusting the appropriate totals accordingly.
