The State Board of Education shall report on this plan to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee by December 15, 2013. The State Board of Education shall report on plan implementation to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee by October 15, 2015.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 2012-2013 school year.
