- 1 moves to amend the bill on page 5, line 16, by adding after the line:
- 2 "Continue 0.75% Sales Tax
- 3 (reduces current rate by 0.25%) \$ 826,600,000 \$ 863,800,000";
- 4 On page 4, line 54, and on page 6, line 59, by increasing the amount reserved to the Savings
- 5 Reserve Account on June 30, 2011 by \$826,600,000;
- 6
- 7 On page 341, line 57, by adding a new section to read:
- 8 **"INCREASE SALES TAX**
- 9 **SECTION 31A.3.(a)** G.S. 105-164.4(a) reads as rewritten:
- 10 "(a) A privilege tax is imposed on a retailer at the following percentage rates of the
- 11 retailer's net taxable sales or gross receipts, as appropriate. The general rate of tax is ~~four and~~
- 12 ~~three-quarters percent (4.75%)~~ five and one-half percent (5.5%)."
- 13 **SECTION 31A.3.(b)** G.S. 105-164.4(a), as rewritten by Section 23.5(a) of this act,
- 14 reads as rewritten:
- 15 "(a) A privilege tax is imposed on a retailer at the following percentage rates of the
- 16 retailer's net taxable sales or gross receipts, as appropriate. The general rate of tax is ~~five and~~
- 17 ~~one-half percent (5.5%)~~ four and seventy-five hundredths percent (4.75%)."
- 18 **SECTION 31A.3.(c)** Subsection (a) of this section becomes effective July 1, 2011,
- 19 and applies to sales made on or after that date. Subsection (b) of this section becomes effective
- 20 July 1, 2013, and applies to sales made on or after that date. The remainder of this section is
- 21 effective when it becomes law.";

- 23 And by adjusting the totals accordingly.
