[YES] Date June 1 Amends Title [NO] Seventh Edition Senator Rucho moves to amend the bill on page 276, lines 42-46 by rewriting those lines to read: With respect to acts of the General Assembly that amend, delete, add to, modify, or repeal any provision relating to apportioning or redistricting of State legislative or congressional districts, the Attorney General of North Carolina shall seek approval of the plan as required by 42 U.S.C. § 1973c.
