16		plan, design, develop, acquire, construct, equip, maintain, and operate
17		transportation infrastructure in this State. An agreement entered into under
18		this subdivision requires the concurrence of the Board of Transportation.
19		The Department shall report to the Chairs of the Joint Legislative
