
1 moves to amend the bill on page 2, between lines 39 and 40, as amended by amendment #1
2 adopted on June 3, 2011 by inserting the following after the subsection added by that
3 amendment:

4 "(j) For the purposes of this section, the North Carolina Medical Board shall not be
5 considered an occupational licensing board.";

6 and on page 2, line 44, by rewriting the line to read:

7 "**SECTION 3.** The Legislative Research Commission shall study the issue of
8 allowing licensure by the North Carolina Medical Board for individuals with military training
9 and experience, for military spouses by endorsement, and for temporary licenses for
10 military-trained applicants or military-spouse applicants. The Commission shall make a report
11 on this issue, including any recommendations or legislative proposals, to the 2012 Regular
12 Session of the 2011 General Assembly upon its convening.

13 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law."
