1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE WAKE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO
3 REDISTRICT THEIR RESIDENCY DISTRICTS AND TO BRING WAKE COUNTY
4 UNDER THE GENERAL LAW CONCERNING FILLING OF VACANCIES ON ITS
5 COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.
6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 153A-22.1(f), as enacted by Chapter 215 of the 1995 Session
8 Laws, and as rewritten by S.L. 1998-175, reads as rewritten:
9 "(f) This section applies to ~~Henderson and Moore~~ Henderson, Moore, and Wake
10 Counties only."
11 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 153A-27.1(h) reads as rewritten:
12 "(h) This section shall apply only in the following counties: Alamance, Alexander,
13 Alleghany, Avery, Beaufort, Brunswick, Buncombe, Burke, Cabarrus, Caldwell, Carteret,
14 Cherokee, Clay, Cleveland, Cumberland, Dare, Davidson, Davie, Forsyth, Graham, Guilford,
15 Haywood, Henderson, Hyde, Jackson, Lee, Lincoln, Macon, Madison, McDowell,
16 Mecklenburg, Moore, Pender, Polk, Randolph, Rockingham, Rutherford, Sampson, Stanly,
17 Stokes, Transylvania, ~~Wake~~, and Yancey."
18 **SECTION 3.** Section 12 of Chapter 763 of the 1981 Session Laws is repealed.
19 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law, except that Sections 2 and
20 3 of this act apply only to vacancies occurring on or after the date this act becomes law.
