1 moves to amend the bill on page 3, lines 37-42, by deleting the lines and substituting the  
2 following:

- 3       "(4a) Any person who meets all of the following conditions:
- 4           a. Is a qualified retired law enforcement officer as defined in G.S. 14-
- 5               415.10.
- 6           b. Is the holder of a concealed handgun permit in accordance with
- 7               Article 54B of Chapter 14 of the North Carolina General Statutes.
- 8           c. Is certified by the North Carolina Criminal Justice Education and
- 9               Training Standards Commission pursuant to G.S. 14-415.26.";

11 and on page 7, line 21, by inserting the following at the end of the line, but before the quotation  
12 mark:

13 "Nothing in this subdivision shall limit the discretion of the sheriff in executing the paperwork  
14 required by the United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms for such person to  
15 obtain the weapon.";

17 and on page 7, line 38, by inserting the following at the end of the line:

18 "Nothing in this subdivision shall limit the discretion of the sheriff in executing the paperwork  
19 required by the United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms for such person to  
20 obtain the weapon.";

21  
22 and on page 10, lines 35 and 36, by deleting the lines and substituting the following:

23 "restore the person's firearms rights is granted who, pursuant to the law of the jurisdiction in  
24 which the conviction occurred, has been pardoned or has had his or her firearms rights restored  
25 if such restoration of rights could also be granted under North Carolina law.";

26  
27 and on page 10, lines 40 through 50, by deleting Section 15 in its entirety;

28  
29 and on page 13, lines 42-43, by deleting the lines and substituting the following:

30       "(b) A person who violates the provisions of this Article other than as set forth in  
31 subsection (a) of this section is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor."";
