

- 1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 22, by adding the following between lines 22 and 23:
- 2 "SECTION 3.1. Sections 1 through 3 of this act become effective only if approved
- 3 by a majority of the qualified voters of the County of Pitt in a referendum. The election shall
- 4 be conducted by the Pitt County Board of Elections in the 2012 general election. The question
- 5 on the ballot shall be:
- 6 " [] FOR [] AGAINST
- 7 Reducing the size of the Pitt County Board of Education from 12 to seven members,
- 8 to provide for four-year terms rather than six-year terms, and to add an at-large member."
- 9 SECTION 3.2. If a majority of the votes cast are in favor of the question, Sections
- 10 1 through 3 of this act become effective as provided therein."
