"For the initial eligibility for the tax credit, for at least the preceding two semesters, the eligible dependent child shall have been either (i) enrolled in a public school or (ii) receiving special education or related services through the public schools as a preschool child with a disability as defined by G.S. 115C-106.3(17), and who is identified with mental retardation as defined in 34 C.F.R. § 300.8(c)(6) or multiple disabilities as defined in 34 C.F.R. § 300.8(c)(7). An eligible dependent child shall be reevaluated every three years by the local educational agency in order to verify that the child continues to be a child with a disability as defined in subdivision (1) of this subsection."; and

On page 3, line 16 by rewriting the line to read:

"(1) Is a child with a disability pursuant to Article 9 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes who is identified with mental retardation as defined in 34 C.F.R. § 300.8(c)(6) or multiple disabilities as defined in 34 C.F.R. § 300.8(c)(7), and who is served in the regular classroom forty-percent (40%) or less of the day."

"For the initial eligibility for the tax credit, for at least the preceding two semesters, semester, the eligible dependent child shall have been either (i) enrolled in a public school or (ii) receiving special education or related services through the public schools as a preschool child with a disability as defined by G.S. 115C-106.3(17), and who is identified with mental retardation as defined in 34 C.F.R. § 300.8(c)(6) or multiple disabilities as defined in 34 C.F.R. § 300.8(c)(7). An eligible dependent child shall be reevaluated every three years by the local educational agency in order to verify that the child continues to be a child with a disability as defined in subdivision (1) of this subsection."".
