	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED	
AN ACT TO PERMIT THE TOWN OF CASWELL BEACH TO EXPEND POWELL BILL FUNDS TO MAINTAIN COMPONENTS OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM WITHIN ITS CORPORATE LIMITS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. Notwithstanding G.S. 136-41.4 or any other provision of law, the Town of Caswell Beach may expend funds allocated to it pursuant to G.S. 136-41.1 for maintenance, repair, reconstruction, or improvement of streets within the Town's corporate limits that form a part of the State highway system. For purposes of this act, "maintenance, repair, reconstruction, or improvement of streets" shall include drainage, curb and gutter, and other necessary appurtenances as well as bikeways or sidewalks located within the right-of-way of any State highway system component and within the corporate limits of the Town. SECTION 2. This act applies only to the Town of Caswell Beach.		

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and expires June 30, 2018.
