The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. Article 7 of Chapter 62 of the General Statutes is amended by adding		
a new section to read as follows:		
"§ 62-133.7A. Rate adjustment mechanism for natural gas local distribution company		
<u>ra</u>	ates.	
In setting rates for a natural gas local distribution company in a general rate case		
proceeding under G.S. 62-133, the Commission may adopt, implement, modify, or eliminate a		
rate adjustment mechanism to enable the company to recover the prudently incurred capital		
investment and associated costs of complying with federal gas pipeline safety requirements,		
including a return based on the company's then authorized return. The Commission shall adopt,		
implement, modify, or eliminate a rate adjustment mechanism authorized under this section		
only upon a finding by the Commission that the mechanism is in the public interest."		

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
