4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 105-41 reads as rewritten:
6	"§ 105-41. Attorneys-at-law and other professionals.
7	(a) Every individual in this State who practices a profession or engages in a business
8	and is included in the list below must obtain from the Secretary a statewide license for the
9	privilege of practicing the profession or engaging in the business. A license required by this
10	section is not transferable to another person. The tax for each license is fifty dollars (\$50.00).
11	
12	(13) A licensed geologist, as defined in G.S. 89E-3.
13	
14	(h) Counties and cities may not levy any license tax on the business or professions
15	taxed under this section.
16	
17	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to taxable years
18	beginning on or after July 1, 2013.
