Short Title: Olympic Games Special Plate Proceeds. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO AMEND THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FROM THE COLLEGIATE AND
3 CULTURAL ATTRACTION PLATE ACCOUNT THAT ARE DERIVED FROM THE
4 SALE OF OLYMPIC GAMES PLATES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-81.12(b4) reads as rewritten:

7 "(b4) Olympic Games. – The Division may not issue an Olympic Games special plate
8 unless it receives 300 or more applications for the plate and the U.S. Olympic Committee
9 licenses, without charge, the State to develop a plate bearing the Olympic Games symbol and
10 name. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction
11 Plate Account derived from the sale of Olympic Games plates to ~~the N.C. Health and Fitness~~
12 ~~Foundation, Inc.,~~ North Carolina Amateur Sports, which will allocate the funds as follows:

- 13 (1) ~~Fifty percent (50%)~~ Sixty-seven percent (67%) to the U.S. Olympic
14 Committee to assist in training ~~olympic~~ Olympic athletes.
15 (2) ~~Twenty five percent (25%)~~ Thirty-three percent (33%) to North Carolina
16 Amateur Sports to assist with administration of the State Games of North
17 Carolina.
18 (3) ~~Twenty five percent (25%) to the Governor's Council on Physical Fitness~~
19 ~~and Health to support local fitness council development throughout North~~
20 ~~Carolina."~~

21 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2013.
