SECTION 2. G.S. 18B-1002(d) reads as rewritten:

8 9 10 "(d) Administrative Procedure. – A permit issued pursuant to this section shall not be issued less than 10 days before any qualifying event described in subdivisions (1) through (5) of subsection (a) of this section. The Commission shall notify the ALE Division not more than three business days after the date a permit is issued pursuant to this section of the name and address of the applicant, the address of the event, and any conditions placed on the permit pursuant to subsection (c) of this section. Denial or revocation of a permit under this section shall not entitle the applicant or permittee to a hearing under Chapter 150B."
