The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. Article 22 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by		
adding a new section to read:		
"§ 14-132.3. Trespass on school grounds.		
(a) For purposes of this section, the term "school premises" includes any school		
building and any educational property as defined by G.S. 14-269.2 that is within 500 feet of a		
school building.		
(b) During the period of one hour prior to the start of school and one hour after the		
conclusion of a school session, it is unlawful for any person to enter the premises of a public or		
private elementary, middle, or secondary school unless the person meets one of the following qualifications:		
-	(1) Is an enrolled student in, a parent or guardian of	an annolled student in or an
	employee of the school or school district.	an emoned student in, or an
	(2) Has permission or an invitation from a school	official to be on the school

	(3) Is attending a school event, class, or meeting to v	which the person, the public

(c)	A violation of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2013, and applies to		



offenses committed on or after that date.
