"(a1) Bills may be introduced on the report of a standing committee. In the case of the Committee on Appropriations, Committee on Finance, or the Committee on Rules, Calendar and Operation of the House, bills may be introduced on behalf of the committee by report of a majority of the minority party of the committee, but bills introduced on the report of the minority shall not be placed on the calendar but instead shall be referred to committee by the chair of the Committee on Rules, Calendar and Operation of the House, and for each of those committees the number of bills introduced on the report of the minority may not exceed one-half of the total introduced on the report of the full committee."
