		instruction, and the certificate shall be valid until revoked by the

	(4)	Any similar certificate issued outside the State by a governmental agency,		
		shall be accepted as complying with the requirements of subsection (a)		
		above, if the privileges are reciprocal for North Carolina residents.		
	(5)	The Wildlife Resources Commission shall adopt rules and regulations to
