1 moves to amend the bill on page 17, line 4, by adding on that line the following:

3 **"BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION**

4 **SECTION 2.14.** G.S. 143B-350(b)(1) reads are rewritten:

5 "(1) Number, appointment. – The Board of Transportation shall have ~~19~~ 21
6 voting members. Fourteen of the members shall be division members
7 appointed by the Governor. Five shall be at-large members appointed by the
8 Governor. One shall be an at-large member appointed by the General
9 Assembly upon recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the
10 Senate, and one shall be an at-large member appointed by the General
11 Assembly upon recommendation of the Speaker of the House of
12 Representatives. At least three members of the Board appointed by the
13 Governor shall be registered voters of a political party other than the
14 political party of the Governor. The Secretary of Transportation shall serve
15 as an ex officio nonvoting member of the Board. No more than two members
16 of the Board may reside in the same highway division."

17 **SECTION 2.15.** G.S. 143B-350(c)

18 "(c) Staggered Terms. – The terms of all Board members serving on the Board prior to
19 January 15, 2001, shall expire on January 14, 2001. A new board of 19 members shall be
20 appointed with terms beginning on January 15, 2001. The Board shall be 21 members
21 beginning January 15, 2013. The Board shall serve the following terms: division members
22 representing divisions 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, and 13 and the three at-large members filling the
23 positions designated in sub-subdivisions (b)(3)a., b., and e. of this section shall serve four-year
24 terms beginning on January 15, 2001, and four-year terms thereafter; and division members
25 representing divisions 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, and 14 and the two at-large members filling the
26 positions designated in sub-subdivisions (b)(3)c. and d. of this section shall serve two-year
27 terms beginning January 15, 2001, and four-year terms thereafter. The terms of at-large
28 members appointed the General Assembly shall be for two years, beginning on January 15,
29 2013." "
