SECTION 2. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:  "§ 20-79.7. Fees for special registration plates and distribution of the fees.  (a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge a single Legion of Valor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War registration plate to a recipient of a Legion of Valor award, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war each year. The preceding special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fees in G.S. 20-88, if the registered weight of the vehicle is greater than 6,000 pounds. All other special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:  Special Plate  Additional Fee Amount

**SECTION 4.** G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(b126) National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for a "National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial" plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of "National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial" plates to the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Fund to support the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, DC."

**SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2013.
